**Aquarion Water Company Announces  
Water Main Installation Project in Westport**  
*Post Road East Project Scheduled to Begin August 28<sup>th</sup>*

BRIDGEPORT, CONN. – August 24, 2017 – Aquarion Water Company today announced a water main installation project beginning at the intersection of Post Road East and Myrtle Avenue in Westport. The installation will progress easterly along the Post Road to Compo Road.

Scheduled to begin August 28, 2017, the work is expected to be completed by the end of 2017. Final road paving will occur in 2018. The project will install approximately 1,500 feet of new 16 inch water main and will greatly improve water distribution capacity.

During the project, customers in the area may experience temporary service disruptions or discolored water. Customers should refrain from washing laundry if water is discolored. Prior to resuming use, customers should run their cold water faucets until the water appears clear.

“We greatly appreciate residents’ patience during this project,” said Alan Huth, Aquarion’s Manager of Utility Programs. “We will work closely with our customers, contractors, and state and town officials to coordinate the work and minimize disruption.”

Work along the Post Road will be conducted at night between the hours of 8pm to 5am and is not expected to cause traffic delays. True Blue Construction, based in Wallingford, CT, was chosen as the contractor for this main installation project.
