**Aquarion Water Company Announces
Water Main Replacement Projects in New Milford**
Forest Hills Main Replacements Scheduled to Begin May 6th

BRIDGEPORT, CONN. – April 25, 2013 – Aquarion Water Company today announced water main replacement projects in the Forest Hills section of New Milford, including Millstone Hill Road, Maple Drive, and Oak Road.

Scheduled to begin May 6, 2013, the work is expected to be completed by July. The project will replace a total of 4,220 feet of undersized water mains with 8-inch ductile iron main, as part of the company's improvement plan to replace aging, leak-prone mains.

During the project, customers in the area may experience temporary service disruptions or discolored water. Aquarion recommends customers store water in their refrigerators for drinking and cooking in case these circumstances arise. Customers also should refrain from washing laundry if water is discolored. Prior to resuming use, customers should run their cold water faucets until the water appears clear.

Due to construction, customer should expect moderate noise and dust, and minor traffic delays during the working hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. John J. Brennan Construction, based in Shelton, CT, was chosen as the contractor for this main replacement project.

“We greatly appreciate residents’ patience during this project,” said George Logan, Aquarion’s Director of Engineering & Planning. “We will work closely with our customers, contractors and local officials to coordinate the work and minimize disruption.”
