BRIDGEPORT, CONN. – September 24, 2014 – Aquarion Water Company today announced the completion of the acquisition of the Bedrock Water Association in New Milford, Connecticut. The acquisition of the system, which provides water to 60 New Milford residents, brings the total number of residents in town served by Aquarion to approximately 8,425.
