Aquarion Water Company Asks Darien Customers To Refrain From Lawn Irrigation During Equipment Repair

BRIDGEPORT, Conn. – June 28, 2016 – As a result of a major water leak at a Darien pumping facility Monday morning and its ongoing emergency repair, Aquarion Water Company today has requested Darien customers refrain from using irrigation systems and hose-end sprinklers until Thursday evening. Hand-held watering is still acceptable during this period.
